The “*Futuros Empresarios*” / *Future Entrepreneurs* (FE) Program began as a community initiative started by the Hispanic Chamber of Commerce of the Lehigh Valley. Since 2009, the Fé Foundation has partnered with local colleges and universities, businesses and other private sponsors to deliver a comprehensive educational life skills and entrepreneurial training program to Lehigh Valley high school students .

Each year we select approximately 30 students and provide them with an opportunity to learn, explore and discover their career interests at no cost to the student.

## OUR VISION

To increase the rate of educational, economic and social success of primarily Latino students and inspire tomorrow’s leaders.

## WHO PARTICIPATES

We are seeking 10th and 11th grade Latino students who are interested in a five week summer entrepreneurial training program at that includes a paid internship with local businesses and organizations.



## EXPECTATIONS

Our corporate and community partners who invite our FE Program interns to become part their team expect the same level of professionalism from their interns as they do of their employees.

Reliability, trust, good communication skills, personal accountability and a desire to do good work are some of character traits that every intern must exhibit, and be committed to, as part of the FE Program.

## PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

FE includes one week residential stay and life skills and academic business training at DeSales University. Upon conclusion of the academic portion of the program, the students will be matched with local businesses/organizations for internships where mentors share real-life business challenges and opportunities. Upon completion of the internship, the students will receive their stipend at the graduation ceremony.

## ADDED BENEFITS

Selected students will be able to participate in the Fé Foundation’s Math and Verbal Enrichment Program (SAT Prep) in the Fall. The Textbook Scholarship program is offered to college and trade school bound FE alumni.
